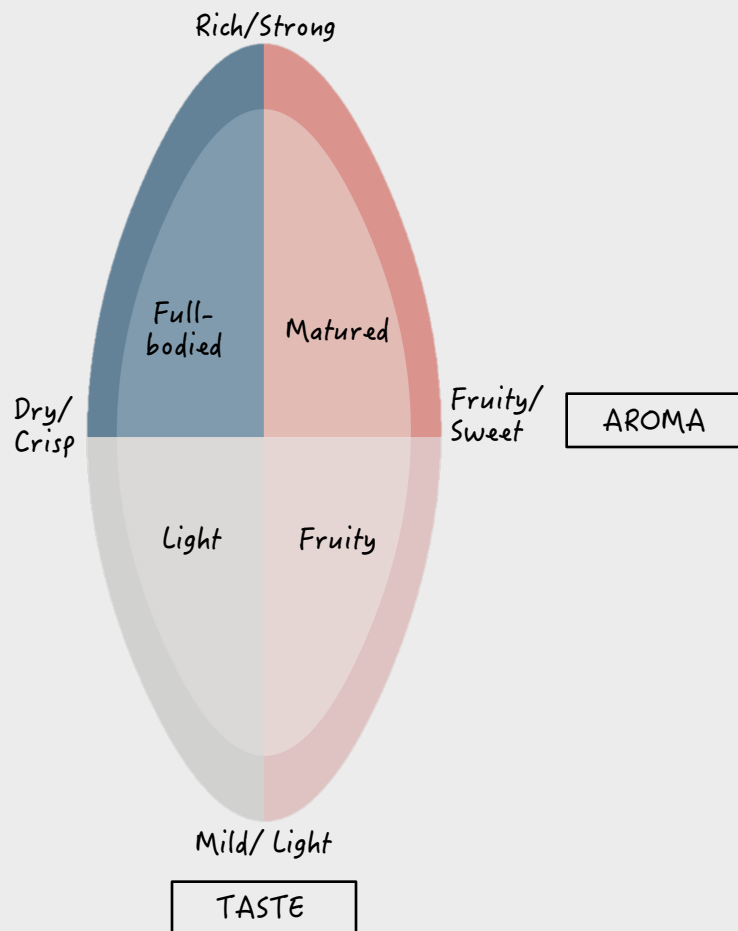


THE SAKE FLAVOR DIAGRAM

You'll be seeing this symbol on our sites very often. What does it mean? Introducing our **sake flavor diagram**! An easy and informative way of understanding a little more of what each sake tastes like.



Sake has a wide range of flavor and this is a very simplified way of looking at the taste profile. Generally, **Light** sakes tend to pair well with lighter tasting food like sashimi/ sushi. Heavier tasting food like tempura and grill items generally will taste well with **full-bodied sake**. A **matured** sakes is a good all rounder for matching most dishes. **Fruity** sakes can be drunk as an aperitif or at the end of the meal.
